

Dear Applicant,

You will be aware that the government has changed GCSE results day this year to the earlier date of Thursday 12 August. We recognise that this is considerably earlier than our planned dates for enrolment and that this might create a period of uncertainty and worry for some students. We have therefore decided to bring our enrolment days forward to **Thursday 12 August** and **Friday 13 August**. This will allow you to enrol with us quickly once you have collected your GCSE results, bringing reassurance and peace of mind about places and courses.

We are very sorry if this change causes any inconvenience, but hope that in most cases this will be a welcome change.

We will write to you at the end of the summer term indicating which of these two dates, and the time, you should attend college to enrol. If you can only attend one of these two dates, don't worry at this stage – please just let us know when you receive your letter if your allocated day is a problem and we will be able to switch the days.

If you know at this stage that you are not available on *both* 12 August and 13 August and you notify us now, we will invite you to attend a late enrolment day on Wednesday 1 September. However, if you attend late enrolment and request to change your courses or have not met the minimum entry requirements of the courses selected at interview, you will only be able to select courses that have remaining availability. We would therefore encourage you to attend the official enrolment days on 12 and 13 August wherever possible.


