PART 1 – COMPULSORY TASKS

Task 1.

Complete the post-performance evaluation questions for your performance of A Midsummer Night's Dream OR Macbeth. This can be found on Teams in the folder for your particular play.

Task 2.

You are going to create a research presentation in to the theatrical genre of Theatre for Children. Your research and findings should include the following headings:

- What is Children's Theatre?
- Theatrical Form and Style of Children's Theatre
- What do Audience's want/expect when watching this type of Theatre?
- How can piece of Children's Theatre affect a child?
- Acting characteristics of Children's Theatre
- Examples of different styles of Children's Theatre performances

Each section should be as detailed as possible, including images and examples from productions.

Task 3.

Project proposal.

In preparation for returning in September you are going to plan a project proposal for a piece of Children's Theatre. In your proposal you should include detailed information about the following:

- Idea for piece
- Performance Style (musical, straight drama, puppets, TIE etc)
- Target Age Range and why
- Key developmental features of this age range
- Ideas and techniques for developing piece that is suitable for age range
- Design Ideas (set and costume)
- Explanation and Justification as to why your idea would make a suitable piece of Children's Theatre for your chosen target age range.
