## Principal's Update - Winter 2023

I would like to express my thanks to parents and students for what has been a very positive start to the academic year. Please find below information about the college and dates of key events taking place over the next few months.

## **Attendance**

Overall attendance in college has been very strong this term. Analysis for sixth form colleges nationally demonstrates the significant impact of attendance on student results. Nationally, for students with 95% attendance or above, 22% of all A level grades exceeded minimum target grade. Students whose attendance falls below 90%, which constitutes persist absence, inevitably tend to underachieve.

We have recently written to all parents and carers with details of their child's attendance so far this year, and you can check this yourself throughout the year by logging into Cedar.

## **Year 12 and Y13 Parents' Evenings**

Parents' Evenings for all students will take place on **Thursday 11** and **Wednesday 17 January** and we will write to parents with details of how to make appointments online. You are welcome to make appointments on either of these two dates. Please note that lessons will end after period 2 on the above dates and college buses will depart at 1.00pm.

## **January External Examinations and Controlled Assessments**

A number of courses have external examinations or controlled assessments taking place in January 2024. These are critically important examinations that contribute to students' final grades and are of equal importance to examinations that traditionally take place at the end of the course.

Timetables for these exams are available to students via Cedar. Full details of external examinations and controlled assessments in January are included at the end of this letter.

The college's Student Code of Conduct sets out clearly defines failure to attend examinations as gross misconduct. A student missing a January exam or controlled assessment for medical reasons will be asked to provide evidence, such as a note from their GP, so that this can be taken into consideration. Failure to attend an examination may result in a financial charge to students and a high-level disciplinary action, or in some cases the withdrawal of the student's place. Failure to attend an examination or controlled assessment might also result in the outright failure of the course and there may not be further opportunities to sit the examination at a later stage.

Thank you for your support, as parents and carers, in ensuring that your child does attend any exams or controlled assessments they are due to complete after Christmas.

# Year 13 A Level Mock Exams

The second and final set of Year 13 mock exams take place between **Wednesday 28 February** and **Tuesday 5 March** (inclusive) and students will be encouraged to develop a 10-week revision plan after Christmas. These exams are important both because preparation for them supports long-term learning, but also because they help students identify strengths and priorities in the time that remains. There are only 14 college weeks from the start of the spring term to the start of the final Year 13 examinations.







## **Year 12 Progression Exams**

Year 12 students will sit larger examinations carried out in formal exam conditions, between **Wednesday 1 May** and **Wednesday 8 May**. These exams are intended to assess whether students are in a sufficiently secure position to continue with their studies at New College Doncaster with their current courses, in Year 13. They help students to prioritise their work and revision as they prepare for Year 13 and help to reinforce learning.

Every student will have a progression interview on Progression Day (Wednesday 3 July) to review how the year has gone and to consider progression into Year 13. We will review results in the Progression Exams as well as attendance, commitment and behaviour. Occasionally, we may ask parents to also attend a meeting in college prior to Progression Day if we have any significant concerns that it would be helpful to discuss with you.

The best way that students can prepare for the final progression exams is to ensure they have worked hard and revised throughout the year, in preparation for the regular monthly assessments. Students will be encouraged to develop a 10-week revision plan after February half-term.

Thank you to parents and carers that are regularly logging into Cedar to track student attendance, progress, support and intervention. You can also use the system to directly email a student's progress tutor and teachers.
