Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach the end of the first half term, I am writing to share with you some information about the upcoming exams for students that will sit an external exam during this academic year.

### Mock Exams

Mock exams will take place twice this year, with the first schedule taking place from Monday 11<sup>th</sup> November to Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November.

For Y12 students, this will be relevant only for those studying:

- A Level Maths for Further Maths
- BTEC Health & Social Care (Diploma and Extended Diploma)
- BTEC Sport (Diploma and Extended Diploma)

The exams are a vital part of the students' preparation, and I would like to take this opportunity to highlight their importance. Mock exams provide students with a valuable opportunity to experience exam conditions, assess their current understanding of the course material, and identify areas that require further attention before their final exams. These assessments can also help students manage exam-related stress, offering a chance to practise time management and refine their exam techniques. Therefore, students are encouraged to approach these exams with focus and dedication.

### GCSE Re-sit Exams

GCSE English and Maths exams take place for those students who have been entered, immediately after half term from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> November.

### Study Advice & Revision

All students have been given a Study Advice Booklet to support them to become effective learners and help them choose the best strategies for remembering in the long term, which is vital for exam success. We also have a study advice section on the Student SharePoint Hub and weekly 'learning takeaways' are shared. Advice to protect students' wellbeing during the exam period is also available in the Study Advice Booklet and on SharePoint. All Y12 students studying Applied General qualifications will have external exams this academic year. Teachers have been helping them to build a detailed and effective revision plan. The results of the GCSE exams will be released on Cedar on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2025. Please note that GCSE students are expected to continue timetabled lessons until January results are known.
