**TASKS** 

1 DRAWINGS

2 PERSONAL WRITING

3 OPTIONAL SKETCHBOOK DRAWING: 6 hours.

4 A5 size drawings
Taking up to 2 hours each: A view, self portrait, a corner of your garden, a plate of food. Work from observation (the real object) *not* a photograph.

Be experimental with textures and surfaces.

PERSONAL STATEMENT : 1 hour

The Temp! 81/2 11" Pencil on Paper

Write a personal statement explaining the following:

(Optional Task) SKETCHBOOK: 4 hours.

Gather your 4 drawings and personal statement into a handmade A5 size sketchbook. Create 2 extra experimental drawing pages of your choice.

### **STARTING SIL**

As part of SIL you will begin one of your A5 drawings in our induction session. This will be an observational drawing of the object on your table.











Drawing from observation means drawing from life not from a photograph.

Choose a medium you would like to work in from the materials table, do not incorporate colour into your drawing just yet. In this piece you want to showcase your skills in creating perspective, texture & shading. This should be a high quality drawing that takes you around 2 hours - you won't finish it during this session but it will get you kick-started on your SIL & give you some ideas!

## **STARTING SIL**









Mixed media means combining at least two (or more) mediums to create a layered & more textured piece.

This is what we mean when we say we want you to be experimental through use of surfaces & textures. This could be your opportunity to include found materials (old receipts, tickets, scraps etc) as well as combining printed image & painted abstract forms...
