Introduction

For Tutorial, your Summer Independent Learning (SIL) is focussed on building on the work that we have done in Tutorial around your future pathways. All the tutorials your tutor has covered can be found on SharePoint for you to revisit should you need to recap anything they have discussed. This is to ensure that you are in a position to begin your applications for university or jobs/apprenticeships upon your return in September.

You need to complete the following tasks:

Task 1 - Complete ALL sections on your UCAS Hub page

You have already registered on UCAS and made a start on all sections of the application form:

- Use the **UCAS Apply Guide for 2026 Entry** to help you with any outstanding sections. This is available on Teams.
- We ask that you do this, even if you are not applying to university, for three reasons:
 - 1. Many students decide very late on that they actually do want to go to university this saves time later on.
 - 2. It is useful for Progress Tutors when they are writing specific job/apprenticeship references as it provides them with a list of qualifications you have previously studied and the exam board that you studied with we don't hold information about the exam board you sat your GCSEs with.
 - 3. The content in a Personal Statement can easily be converted to an application letter to prospective employers and apprenticeship providers.

You should have set up your username and password in tutorial.

Task 2 - Personal Statement

Task 2 requires you to submit a 1st draft of your personal statement via Teams before your first tutorial back.
