

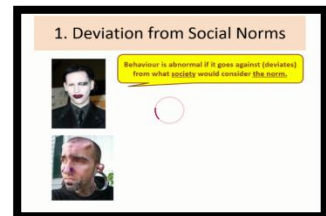

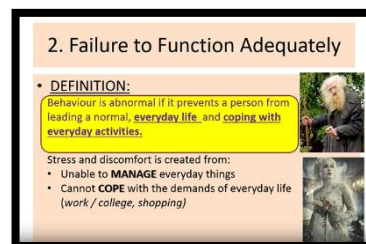
Lesson 2- Deviation from Social Norms

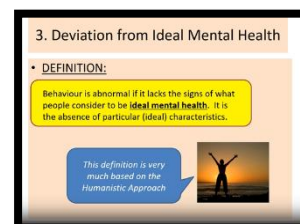
Lesson 3 – Failure to Function Adequately

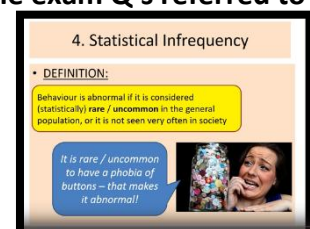
Lesson 4 – Deviation from Ideal Mental Health
