Results and Progression Day

We hope that preparations for your Progression Exams are going well. These exams (week commencing 15 June) are designed to support your learning, to help you identify strengths and weaknesses, to receive feedback, to plan your next steps, and to check that you are ready for the next stage of your learning in Year 13.

During the week of the Progression Exams, there will be no A-Level lessons taking place (except for Visual Arts subjects). All BTEC and Applied General lessons will however run as normal and students studying these qualifications are expected to attend lessons as normal.

We are looking forward to meeting with all Year 12 students at the **Results and Progression Day**, which takes place on **Friday 3 July**. This is your last day of the summer term.

ALL students must attend the Results and Progression Day in order to progress into Year 13.

The day will involve:

- A Year 12 assembly celebrating successes of the year, recognising individual students and awarding prizes
- The collection of your personal summary sheet, which will include your Progression Exam results, current BTEC/Applied General performance, your attendance, the stage of any formal behaviour and conduct actions that have been taken, and details of your current course enrolments
- An individual interview with a member of staff, or a member of the Senior Leadership Team
- The completion of administration required to progress into Year 13
- A workshop to support your applications for university, apprenticeships or employment
- A session delivered by an external speaker

Your individual interview will explore how you have performed in your Progression Exams and will review your continued study at New College Doncaster and the courses you will study in September. We will take into consideration issues such as attendance, behaviour and commitment. There will also be a discussion as to whether you are required to re-sit any of your Progression Exams and when this will take place.

Arrival and Departure Times

All students should arrive in college by **8.50am** and report to the Sports Hall where you will collect your individual summary sheet and your timetable for the day.

The timetabled activities for the day will finish at approximately 2.00pm. All college buses will depart at the earlier time of **2.10pm**.

Your teachers will share with you details of your Summer Independent Learning (SIL) activities in the coming weeks.
