Enrichment trips and visits are designed to support both learning and the personal development of students. They provide opportunities to explore a subject in greater depth, beyond the curriculum or within a particular setting, help prepare students for their next steps in education or employment, or develop cultural capital, skills and appreciation of the world around us.

The purpose of the visit is: Skiing and Snow Sports trip to Sestriere, Italy

The coach will depart from New College Doncaster to take us to our airport (northern airport requested), where we will fly to Turin. Our transfer will then take approximately 1.5 hours to the resort of Sestriere, Italy. Sestriere forms part of the much larger Milky Way ski area with other well-known resorts including Sauze d'Oulux and Sansicario. With over 400 km of pistes, the Milky Way forms one of the world's largest ski areas. At 2000m above sea level, the resort of Sestriere has a good track record for snow.

All levels are welcome and we encourage students from all areas of college to come and ski or snowboard\* regardless of previous ability (*\*the availability for snowboard tuition will be dependent on the number of students selecting this as an option. An additional fee of approx. £40 will apply*). It's a great opportunity to either learn to ski or snowboard or to perfect your technique.

Please confirm your place by providing a **deposit of £300 by Friday 16<sup>th</sup> October 2026**, *the terms of our provider also state that when paying the deposit, you are committed to pay a further deposit payment scheduled to be collected by the 1<sup>st</sup> December 2026.*

Our annual Ski Enrichment Trip is always hugely popular, and we only have approximately 40 spaces available for the visit, it will therefore be on a first-come basis and we anticipate it filling up fast with students already expressing a strong interest.

The college reserves the right to refund any deposits if we feel it is necessary, including students who have poor attendance or where there are concerns in relation to behaviour.

There is an expectation that students have a suitable level of fitness for the trip as it can be quite challenging. Please note that all students are expected to ski/snowboard on all morning and afternoon sessions for the full duration of the trip, unless they have a medical exemption.

The total payment of £1,965 is payable to *NCLT* by **1<sup>st</sup> November 2027**.

#### **How to pay and secure your place.**

Places can be secured via the online college shop (<https://nclt.collegestore.uk/>) and all payments will need to be made via the college shop. **When making a payment, students will be added to a Microsoft Teams Group where they can submit their current ability level, full name (as it appears on their passport) and D.O.B.**

Due to the cost being £1,965 we offer payments in instalments and spread over the forthcoming months. All Payments are **compulsory**, and dates must be adhered to. You can pay more of the balance off early if you would like by the above methods
